

Dr. C. (Cor) J. van Montfort

Cor van Montfort (1961) is senior researcher at de Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, member of the National Education Council and research fellow at Tilburg University. In his current research he focuses on:

- the relation between good governance, public accountability and the quality of education (Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam);
- Public-private partnerships for livable cities (Tilburg University).

Together with research groups from all over the world he is working on an edited volume about this topic.



He studied political science at the Katholieke Universiteit Nijmegen and did his Phd. about civil society and institutional reform at Utrecht University. Between 1995 and 2018 he worked for the Netherlands Court of Audit as a project manager, program manager and head of the sections 'public-private partnerships' and 'education'. He was also chairman of national commissions on codes of good governance in child care and higher education.

From 2007 to 2015 he was professor by special appointment at Tilburg University and specialized in good governance and public-private arrangements.

During his carrier he published about public private partnerships, public entrepreneurship, public value management, good governance and public accountability in different policy domains like pension provision, social security, water management, social housing and education.

In the past years he performed several research projects and advisory projects on request of the Dutch government and the Dutch parliament on the topics of social security, good governance, social housing and education.
